Church Camp Rules

Camp Director has final rule of discipline, including sending a camper home!

- 1. You must bring an open heart for God.
- 2. Be on time for meals, classes, services, activities, and to bed each night.
- 3. Come to meals neat and clean.
- 4. Keep your rooms clean. You don't want the "Dirty Bill" award.
- 5. Respect for other campers, counselors, and helpers is expected at all times.
- 6. No foul language. This includes cursing and taking God's name in vain.
- 7. No fighting or rough horseplay.
- 8. No public display of affection. This includes hand-holding.
- 9. Shaving cream must be given to counselor to be dispensed as needed. No shaving cream fights!
- 10. Campers are not to leave the campground without permission.
- 11. Due to space limitations, sleeping arrangements are final.
- 12. All medications should include instructions and are to be turned in to the camp nurse upon arrival to camp. Report any injury, illness, cut or rash to camp nurse.
- 13. Campers must be in their rooms by 10:00 p.m. with lights out at 11:00 p.m.
- 14. To leave for a practice, game, or doctor's appointment, the Camp Director must have written parental permission and name of person picking camper up.
- 15. No camper will be allowed to "hang out" in their room or in the kitchen during the day.
- 16. Shorts are allowed during the day, but they MUST TOUCH THE KNEE!
- 17. During the evening services girls must wear dresses that touch the knee. No slits above the knee and no tank tops or sundresses without a shirt underneath or over top. Sleeveless dresses must not be loose under the arm. No low cut or loose tops. Everything must be covered!
- 18. No tight clothing including shorts, shirts, skirts, or dresses. No yoga pants or leggings. No writing on the back of shorts/pants.
- 19. MODESTY is of the utmost importance. We dress up to worship God because He deserves our best and church is a BIG DEAL!
- 20. No tight tank tops with a side-less shirt over top.
- 21. Boys must wear dress slacks and a collared shirt, no T-shirts/ shorts, to the evening services.
- 22. Girls may wear bathing suits and boys must wear swimming trunks. Don't forget your towel. For night or combines swimming everyone must wear dark T-shirts.
- 23. Campers are not to bring cell phones, radios, CD/DVD players, computers, iPods, Air Pods, portable TVs, or coolers with food, snacks, or cases of pop. A telephone will be available for emergencies only. Any of the above items will be confiscated until the end of the week.
- 24. No weapons of any kind, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products (vaping devices, e-cigarettes, or chew), any illegal drugs, or hazardous items (combustible fluids, lighters, candles, or fireworks).
- 25. PLEASE PICK UP ALL TRASH AND PLACE IN GARBAGE CANS.
